### Record of Proceedings

(Date of Hearing: 03.12.2025) (Date of Order: 03.12.2025)

- 1. The present Interlocutory Application has been filed by the Petitioner/Applicant inter-alia praying to:
  - a. Allow the Petitioner to levy on provisional basis Power Purchase Cost Adjustment Charges to the tune of 9.00% for Q-2 of FY 2025-26 for a period of three months, i.e. from 01.11.20205 till 31.01.2026, pending issuance of the final order in the present Petition; or, in the alternative
  - b. Allow the Petition to continue to levy the Power Purchase Cost Adjustment Charges @7.36% as allowed vide Order dated 07.08.2025 in Petition No. 31 of 2025 (which was in force as on 31.10.2025), on an interim basis for a period of three months, i.e., from 01.11.2025 till 31.01.2026;
- The Ld. Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of the Petitioner/Applicant submits
  that since the instant Petition may require examination of PPAC claim of the
  Petitioner, hence, the Interim relief as sought for in the I.A. be considered for

approval by the Commission. It is observed that prayer (a) of the IA cannot be allowed at this stage without examination of the PPAC claim related to Q-2 of the FY 2025-26. However, in the interest of justice, prayer (b) of the IA is allowed and accordingly, the Petitioner may continue to levy the Power Purchase Cost Adjustment Charges @ 7.36% as allowed vide Order dated 07.08.2025 in Petition No. 31 of 2025 (which was in force upto 31.10.2025), on an interim basis from today till final disposal of the instant Petition or till 31.01.2026, whichever is earlier.

- 3. IA No. 19/2025 is disposed in the above terms. If any clarifications are required by the Officers of the Commission, the same shall be provided by the Petitioner.
