Reference: DERC Renewable Purchase Obligation and Renewable Energy Certificate Framework Implementation Regulations, 2012

Dear Sir,

We write with reference to the aforementioned Regulations which mandate the Distribution Licensees to furnish half yearly progress report on Renewable Capacity Addition, generation and purchase of electricity from Renewable Sources in their area. The excerpt of relevant Regulation 4.4 is provided below for ready reference:

"(4) The Licensee(s) shall submit half yearly progress report to the Commission, on the capacity addition, generation and purchase of electricity from renewable energy sources in their area(s) of supply, which is used by generator itself or sold to third party under open access, and also post them on their website.



Accordingly, we hereby submit the report for H2 FY 2019-20 in the table below:-

^{*} Hon'ble Commission may consider that because of COVID-19 Lock Down, only few Solar Roof Top generation bills could be invoiced for the month of March 2020 and for the remaining cases, estimation is done based on Provisional Billing logic (last year same month). However, the actual data will be provided to you at the earliest when the Lock Down ends and billing for the Solar Roof Top generation is done.

The Renewable Energy Capacity addition in H2 FY 2019-20 has been 4.33 MWp.

We hope that the Hon'ble Commission would find the above in order and we shall be pleased to furnish any other information/ clarification as and when required.
