COVID 19 Vaccination for CSR Beneficiaries

COVID 19 Vaccination is the need of the hour. It is one of the most effective method of fighting the pandemic but in JJ clusters there is still a hidden fear about getting vaccinated. Therefore to sensitize the community, an awareness session was organised on 18th May with ABHAs of different Districts sensitizing them about Covid-19 and its vaccination process. ABHAs were explained about the New Variant of Covid-19 Disease & its symptoms, DOs and Don'ts, guidelines by Government of India and how to take precautionary measures while going outside. Also, they were made aware about Covid-19 Vaccine & its importance, DOs and Don'ts before and after vaccination, documents required for registration and eligibility criteria. The ABHAs were further expected to disseminate the information within community and encourage the people to overcome their fear and contribute in breaking the Covid chain for a safe future. Additionally, to help our CSR Beneficiaries to complete the process, Tata power-DDL with support from Tata Group, has started a vaccination camp at CENPEID (Tata Power - DDL Learning Centre, Rohini, Sector 11). The camp along with the employees, also offered a safe and systematic way to the community people for getting vaccinated in the current situation. Till now more than 170 CSR project staff/ Men and women engaged in various initiatives such as ABHAs, WLC Women, RO Operator and Mobile Dispensary Staff etc. have successfully been vaccinated with COVISHIELD Vaccine.

Health Services to Community

Tata Power-DDL provided "Covid Relief Support" to Delhi government by donating Health & Hygiene items under its SIG-Sanjeevani program, which consists of PPE Kits (2000 nos.), Infrared Thermometers (1000 nos.), Steam Inhalers (2000 nos.), Digital Thermometers (2000 nos.), Pulse Oxymeters (3000 nos.) Liquid Base Sanitizers (1200 Cans) etc. in the month of May 2021.

Apart from this, the company also facilitated Telemedicine Services to its targeted community of JJ Clusters, re-settlement colonies by deploying its Para Medical Team of 4 Mobile Dispensaries. The team focussed on conducting awareness campaign on Covid-19 disease and its precautions and benefits of the vaccination to the target community. In order to ensure that people follow the lockdown guidelines while maintaining their health, the team also distributed Covid medicines/Immunity Booster Kits to the people who are under home isolation with mild symptoms of Covid-19 and who do not require hospitalization".

Uninterrupted potable water services provided to 25 government schools which were converted into Covid-19 Vaccination Centres during the pandemic through the commercial RO Plants installed by Tata Power-DDL. The school authorities appreciated Tata Power-DDL for the support during the hour of need.

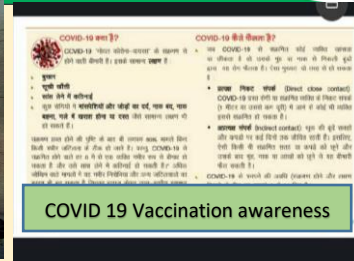

YAAS Cyclone Relief Camp
