Inauguration of RO Plants & Plantation Drive at Government Schools

Tata Power-DDL has dedicated 2 Commercial RO Plants at Sarvodaya Bal Vidyalaya and Sarvodaya Kanya Vidyalaya, Nathupura, Burari in its operational area under its SIG-Sanjeevani Program for the benefit of students and teaching staff of the schools. These schools are closely associated with Tata Affirmative Action and Club Enerji Program. The RO Plants installed at Sarvodaya Bal Vidyalaya and Sarvodaya Kanya Vidyalaya, Burari was inaugurated on 25th August 2020 by Mr. Ganesh Srinivasan, CEO, Tata Power-DDL & Mr. Shrutibodh Agarwal, Dy. Director of Education (North) in the gracious presence of Senior Officials of Tata Power-DDL, Team SIG, Principals, Teaching staff, School Management Committee Members (SMC).

The RO Plant installed by Tata Power-DDL with the capacity of purifying 500 Litres Water per Hour (LPH) directly cater to the requirement of potable water to 7000 plus students of the schools every day. Tata Power-DDL has installed 74 such RO Plants at Educational Institutions, JJ Clusters and Delhi Metro stations in its operational area, which directly benefited 3.6 Lakh of people every day.

The RO inauguration followed by a mega plantation drive was also inaugurated by CEO at Sarvodaya Bal Vidyalaya (SBV) where approx. 2000 saplings were planted. An online interaction session on educational front with the students of SBV was also conducted, wherein our CEO wished the students to achieve greater heights in their academic performance.

Virtual Session for VT Students

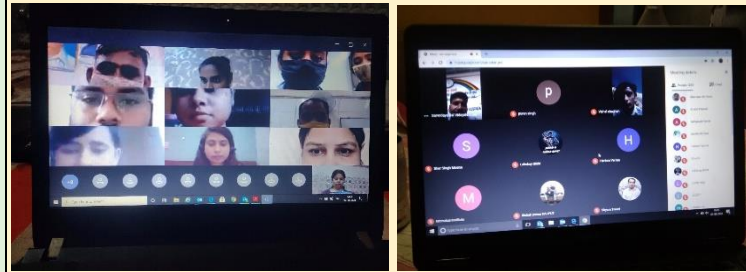
