Do you know? Water Purification Methods *-Shamshad Ahmed (SIG)*

When reverse osmosis is not available, there are 5 water purification methods:-

1. Boiling-In this method, clean water should be boiled and left to boil for **1-3** minutes.

2. Filtration-This method uses chemical and physical processes to purify water, filtration is considered effective when it comes to selective elimination of much smaller molecular compounds such as chlorine and pesticides.

3. Distillation- This method uses heat to collect pure water in the form of vapor. This vapor is directed into a condenser to cool. It gets reversed into liquid water that is clean and safe for drinking. This method is effective in removing bacteria, germs, salts, heavy metals such as lead, mercury and arsenic. 4. Chlorination-kills germs, parasites and other

disease-causing organisms found in ground or tap water.

5. Use Ultraviolet Light-This looks similar to a small flashlight. You just swish it around in the water for a few minutes and the bacteria can already be killed.
