Tata Power-DDL witnessed active participation from SLT members, employees and BA employees through which it successfully organised 440 volunteering activities, wherein 9,489 volunteering count and 21,629 volunteering hours were registered. In this month-long program, several online sessions on Ethics, Personality Development, Interview Skills, Safety, COVID-19 etc. and offline activities for instance plantation, cleanliness drive, RO plant inauguration, ration & hygiene kits distribution in clusters etc. were conducted which led to this grand success.
