### TAAP Jury Award

Tata Power-DDL was conferred with 4 awards at the Tata Affirmative Action Programme (TAAP) Annual Convention 2019 held on September 16, 2019 at Taj Mahal Palace, Mumbai. The company received the awards in the following categories - TAAP Jury Award, Award for largest company with highest score in 'Employment' and 'Entrepreneurship' and the 'Best Practices for the Year 2019' for Tata Power-DDL's ABHA model. The Jury also appreciated Tata Power-DDL's Leadership approach of linking Affirmative Action (AA) to its Business strategy.

### India CSR Summit 2019

Mr. Piyush Goyal (Head – Corporate Services) was one of the panellists at the session on 'Cluster-based Approach in CSR: Collaborations for Impacts', organised by South Asia's largest CSR, SDGs and Social Impact Forum – 'India CSR Summit & Exhibition' on September 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>. The emphasis was laid on the ABHA model and how it has been a successful Cluster Based Approach model in 220+ JJ clusters. The story was supported by a video. Tata Power-DDL under its policy of Tata Affirmative Action Program (TAAP) has initiated a Mentor Mentee session for ITI students. This year 213 Students from Sir C. V. Raman Industrial Training Institute (ITI) Dheerpur & 188 students from ITI Jahangirpuri were selected for the Mentor Mentee Session. Orientation sessions were held for the mentors (Tata Power-DDL employees) and mentees (ITI Students) for this academic session on September 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> respectively. This is a platform where the senior leadership team is directly involved with the CSR beneficiaries and contributes for their better growth in both academic & professional spheres.

### Training for ABHA, SHG and WLC women

Chef Sadaf Hussain conducted a session on Health & Nutrition on September 14, 2019 wherein 100 beneficiaries were given a demo of his selected recipes.
