Inauguration of RO Plant at Sarvodaya Bal Vidyalaya, Narela

Tata Power Delhi Distribution Limited has always believed in working towards the betterment and upliftment of underprivileged sections of the society. In line with the endeavor, Tata Power-DDL has dedicated one Commercial RO Plant at Sarvodaya Bal Vidyalaya, Pocket-2, Sector A6, Narela. The RO Plant was inaugurated on 23rd September, 2021 by Mr. Suranjit Mishra, CFO, Tata Power-DDL in the gracious presence of Mr. Dwijadas Basak, Chief (Customer Experience, Commercial & SIG), Mr. KK Suman, Chief (SIG, VCG, CCG & SCG), Ms. Geetanjali Tripathi (HOG-SIG), Team SIG-Ujjwal & Sanjeevani along with Principal and school staff.

The RO Plant installed in the School purifies 500 Litre Water per Hour (LPH) and more than 2000 students and teaching staff of the School gets benefit of Potable water every day. Tata Power-DDL has installed 83 such RO Plants at Educational Institutes, JJ Clusters (Slums), Metro Stations, which directly benefits 3.78 Lakh people every day. Clean water is essential for good health!


